STRIKE ON 10th JULY

The National Union of Teachers has led the fight against the Government's attacks on our pensions, pay and conditions of service. The action we have taken has brought results, but the Government and the Secretary of State for Education are still refusing to discuss key issues for the profession.

- Accountability must be reformed so that workload comes down
- There must be a fair national pay system
- There must be a recognition that teachers cannot work to 68



Therefore the National Executive of the NUT has decided that we will be taking action in England and Wales on 10th July alongside other unions. Unison, GMB and Unite are planning to call upon members in local government and education to take strike action on the same day.

You do not need to give your headteacher the names of individuals going on strike – they are only legally entitled to know the number of NUT members in the school.
